Apparently, such design changes were not within the scope of what the NYU Classes Sakai platform could do.

Dr. Poling always did what she could to help students, faculty, staff, patients, and all other individuals who came to Department of Orthodontics at NYUCD. Dr. Poling created four Invisalign Training

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Websites with about 40 presentations each to help third- and fourth-year dental students as well as orthodontic residents, faculty, and alumni perform Invisalign clinical procedures in a standardized way.

In 2015, Dr. Poling started teaching first-year orthodontic residents and International Fellows how to examine an orthodontic patient, produce and analyze orthodontic records, diagnose, write a problem list, set treatment objectives, write treatment options, select a treatment option, submit a case to PG Invisalign, present treatment options to a patient for acceptance, and write a final treatment plan for Invisalign Therapy. These residents then treated about 35 patients each year with Full Invisalign under the supervision of Dr. Poling. Several cases addressed unique unanswered questions in orthodontics such as movement of fixed bridges, dentoalveolar expansion, closure of skeletal openbites, and use of micro-osteoperforations to facilitate special difficult tooth movements.

Community Service

From 2019 to the present Dr. Poling has been an active leader in the League of Women Voters of North Carolina in supporting local and statewide public schools.

In 2021, Dr. Poling organized, funded, and donated 1500 child sized toothbrushes, 500 20-page "Your Child's Teeth" Booklets, 300 "Your Child's Teeth" Booklets in Spanish, 500 6-panel English 'Your Child's Teeth" brochures, and 1000 distribution bags to North Carolina Smart Start and Head Start PreK programs for distribution to the children in those programs.

2007-to present -Dr. Poling was a Board member and now is CEO of the Children's Healthy Smiles Project at http://childrenssmileproject.org/, a California non-profit corporation that distributes dental supplies and dental educational materials to children of need. In 2015, CHSP received a Donation Grant from Henry Schein Cares Foundation for 6 Adult Oral Hygiene Kits (432 brushing packs) to be delivered to PS 721X Steven McSweeney School and 721X at Monroe, high schools for students with developmental disabilities, both in the Bronx. Dr. Poling did this in April 2015 and gave instruction to the teachers and the developmentally disabled students. Dr. Poling was acting as a representative of CHSP, and also as faculty at NYUCD.

From 2007 to 2018 ITI had the website www.ITICourses.com that delivered unique training to dental assistants who wanted to become orthodontic assistants. The courses on this website were the only online training courses approved by the Dental Board of California for teaching dental assistants to prepare them for the California Orthodontic Assistant Permit Exam. In 2020, the International Training Institute was dissolved.

Since 2018, Dr. Poling has been the primary author for the courses delivered on the new training website, www.OrthoTraining.com which uses the Sakai Learning Management System with SCORM Cloud tracking of students' learning activities. Dr. Poling, together with Mr. Suresh Kolpuru and his team of developers, programmers, website designers, and quality assurance analysts, have been able to create new educational software for teaching, and quick learning that advances the delivery of high-quality orthodontic care to individuals all over the world. In May, 2022, OrthoTraining became an American Dental Association-Continuing Education Recognized Provider of Continuing Education, and is the only dental education provider of this type delivering hybrid courses online to dental professionals.
